

2019 ALBERTA STEEL DESIGN AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION PROCESS

AWARD CATEGORIES:

Applicants can enter a project in more than one category. (JUDGES MAY ALSO DECIDE TO CONSIDER A SUBMISSION FOR ANY CATEGORY.)

Architectural Award

Steel structures in which architectural considerations significantly influence the design, particularly those with exposed steelwork. (All building types.)

Engineering Award

Steel structures in which engineering considerations and the efficient use of steel in unique applications are a significant factor. (All building types.)

Building Communities Award

Steel structures created as part of a community development project with a focus on serving community needs. This includes but is not limited to municipal government projects, not for profit companies, public art installations, and other installations (all building types, and structures). Projects that impact and enhance the community around them will be considered.

Steel Edge Award

An open category looking for tremendous innovation and ingenuity in the application of steel design, fabrication, detailing or finishing. For example:

- Steel is used in a nonconventional way,
- Steel application addresses a particular complexity
- Steel address a resource or application challenge

This may be innovation within an entire project or a single project element.

Sustainability Award

Steel structures in which steel has been used or re-used as part of a sustainable development project that aims to improve environmental impact of the structure by using established and innovative design, standards and technologies.

Bridge Award

An award for a steel bridge project that demonstrates outstanding use of steel in design and construction.

Collaboration Award

An award for a project team who demonstrate "value added" to the project through collaborative project delivery approaches throughout the design and/or construction process. Factors for consideration will include:

- Early involvement of key participants
- Shared risk and reward based on the projects outcome
- Joint project control

- Jointly developed and validated targets
- Large team meetings for Design and Resolution Communication and Planning
- Innovative Use of Technology

Focus for the Collaboration award is on the successful delivery COLLABORATION process, yet final design quality will remain a consideration.

SUBMISSION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must illustrate ingenuity and innovation in the use of structural steel or plate work.
- The steelwork for the project must be brought to a stage where it is functioning or operating as intended by **January 31, 2019**.
- An Alberta CISC member must be involved in the project. If the applicant is an Associate CISC member and the steel fabricator is not a CISC member, that fabricator will not be eligible to receive an award and will not be referenced in any of the Awards materials.
- The project may be located outside Alberta.
- All submissions are considered regardless of size and costs involved.
- Past submissions that have not been an award winner can be re-submitted once only (Note a new submission must be completed).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION PROCESS...CONTINUED

SUBMISSION PROCESS:

The submission process for the CISC 2019 Alberta Steel Design Awards Of Excellence is completed in **two easy steps**.

STEP 1 Enter ¹**General Project Information**

- Go to <https://www.cisc-alberta-steel-design-awards.network/>
- Create a User ID
- Verify the user ID from the email that you will receive
- Log in and complete and submit the **general project information** and **team members**
- Press "Create Submission" at the bottom of the page
- **General Project Information is due by December 14, 2018**

STEP 2 Complete a **Project Submission Form**

- Go to <https://www.cisc-alberta-steel-design-awards.network/>
- Complete the remainder of the form and ensure you identify all Team Members for the project. This includes architects, engineers, developers etc.
- Once the submission is complete press "Create Submission and Submit for Judging"
- **Submit no later than January 15, 2019**

What information is required in the Submission form?

- Name and contact information for each project team member.
- The brief description will be used as an introductory paragraph describing the projects for use in Awards promotional materials
- Use the Full Description space to give a more thorough description of the project
- Use the description boxes under each category description to further explain why it deserves to win in this category. (The text box will appear when you click the Category you are submitting for.)

It is important that the General Project Information section be received in order to verify a project's eligibility and provide information to assist in the Award's Celebration Planning.
